They maintain *Lathyrus sativus* material which originates from breeding research in the 1990s. The genotypes are mainly of Slovak origin, obtained mainly from collection expeditions in their territory. From these genotype they can provide 100 seeds per genotype.

Evaluation data available.

The release of items from their gene bank is carried out on the basis of the Standard Material Transfer Agreement (SMTA), which is internationally valid. The release of samples is free of charge. The applicant hereby undertakes that the seed material of plant genetic resources will be used only for the purposes of research, breeding and testing for the food and agriculture industry.

The results obtained based on the provision of their genetic material should be provided back to their database.
